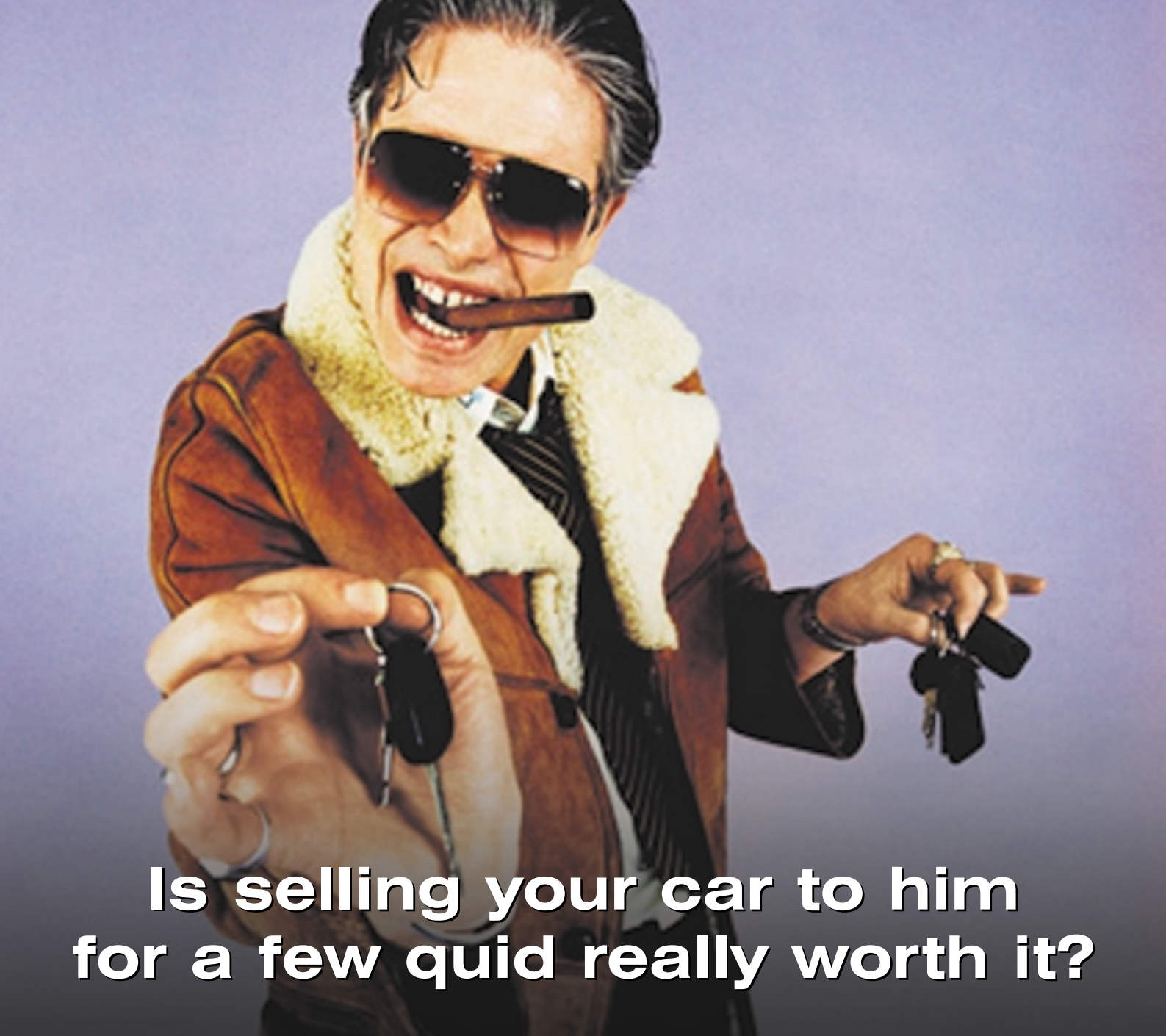
Over 200,000 cars are abandoned every year, spoiling the countryside, damaging vegetation and wildlife and costing the taxpayer up to £5,000 each to recover.

RECYCLE YOUR CAR

If you get rid of your car and it is subsequently abandoned you could face fines of up to £2500 as an illegal dumper or three months in prison under the Refuse Disposal Act. But by taking your old car to a registered Authorised Treatment Facility you will ensure that the vehicle will be properly depolluted so that hazardous substances like oil and lead do not escape into the environment and at least 85% of its materials will be recycled.



Is selling your car to him for a few quid really worth it?

Get a Certificate of Destruction for your old car or you could be landed with a £2,500 fine for illegal dumping or 3 months in prison.

RECYCLE YOUR CAR

The End of Life Vehicles (ELV) Directive makes the last owner of a vehicle responsible for ensuring it is disposed of in an environmentally sound way by a registered Authorised Treatment Facility. If you don't obtain a Certificate of Destruction you could be liable for continued road tax bills and if the car is subsequently abandoned you could be fined up to £2500 as an illegal dumper and could face three months in prison under the Refuse Disposal Act.
